



When you insert the Installation CD (CD-ROM) and execute ADVC mini.mpkg, the setup program starts and the following screen appears. Follow the instructions on the screen to install the application (ADVC capture). After the installation is completed, connect ADVCmini. (Refer to "Connection Procedure" on page 10.)



Connection Connector Names

Figure 2. ADVCmini Front Panel



(1) Power indicator LED

When power is provided from USB port, this indicator lights in green.

- (2) S-Video input connector
- (3) Composite input connector
- (4) Audio input connectors

The red connector is used for the right (R) audio input, and the white connector is for the left (L) audio input.





Figure 4. ADVCmini Right Side View



- (5) USB port
- (6) SCART input connector

The SCART input connector is only for use in EU countries.

Connection Procedure

Use the following procedure to connect ADVCmini.


- (1) Use the USB cable to connect ADVCmini to the PC.
- (2) Use the video/audio cable to connect ADVCmini to the playback device.
 - If the playback device supports S-Video, you can use an S-Video cable for connection. In this case, you do not have to use the video cable in addition to the S-Video cable. (Connect the audio cable only.)
 - A SCART cable is supplied with models for EU countries. If the playback device supports SCART, you can use a SCART cable for connection. In this case, you do not have to use either the video/audio cable or the S-Video cable.
- Note Connect the cables in the order of USB cable → video/audio cable (or S-Video cable, SCART cable).

Operating Application Application Screen

When you start the application (ADVC capture), the following screen appears.

- (1) Video playback screen
- (2) File save destination selection box
- (3) Counter
- (4) Video source selection box Clicking the SCART input button switches the input in the order of Composite input → S-Video input → RGB input.
- (5) REC button
- (6) STOP button
- (7) Audio level adjustment bar
- (8) Image quality adjustment box You can adjust the image quality (hue, brightness, etc.) of the video source. The adjustments made here are reflected during capture. Normally, use the default values.

Capture Procedure

Use the following procedure to capture.

- (1) Select the video source for the input from the video source selection box.
- (2) Select the save destination for the file from the file save destination selection box.
- (3) Click the REC button to start capture.
- (4) Click the STOP button to stop capture.
