### **WARNINGS**

# Using Software 2.0.x with Firmware 2.1 can prevent the iControl panel from opening Firmware 2.1 has one additional BBC LUT in the list of available LUTs. When using Software (XIP-3901-UC iControl panel) 2.1, the user can select this new BBC LUT. If Software 2.0.x is still in use in the system, there are two consequences: 1) The 2.0.x panel will not open because the BBC LUT selection is out of range. 2) If the 2.0.x panel is already open, the BBC LUT selection combo box will remain on the preceding selection because the new LUT does not exist in its list. Recommendation: Install Software 2.1.




