File Ops	When saving files to an NTFS USB stick, the file permissions are being saved for user 'Every- one' which causes problems on some PCs. Workaround: Use Fat32 for USB stick, add 'Everyone' user to the PC, and change file permis- sions on the folders.	38070
File Ops	Cancelling a Show File update may result in files being erased from the show. Workaround: Verify the show contents after cancelling an update and if there are files missing, update the show again by pressing the Update Show button.	40743
Frame Status	Kayenne Menu does not report Video Frame power supply over temperature. Workaround: Power supply status is reported in web page and frame logs.	40925
Image Store	Image Store Library workflow results in folders being inaccessible by the Image Store. Workaround: When folders are transferred from Windows into the Images Folder make sure the folder Properties / Security / Advanced / Permissions "Inherit from parent the permission entries that apply to child objects." is checked.	38271

Router Interface Router destinations with unique names longer than 8 characters but not unique for the first 8 characters will have problems. (Standard nomenclature for current router environments is to have 8 characters or less.) Workaround: Router destinations and sources must be unique for the first 8 characters.		106188
